A typical Seed Phrase looks like the example below, if it was created in an App called Xaman

187354 If anybody finds your Seed Phrase, they can access your XRP Wallet, 296001 without your permission and remove all of your XRP in less than 1 minute. 327967 So, it is very risky and difficult to prepare for things like Theft, Fire, Flood, 713229 Death etc. The simplest way is to convert your Seed Phrase to something 002654 "nobody" could recognise as a Seed Phrase, even if you gave it to them. 370421 To achieve, changing your Seed Phrase you will be creating a unique 876009 Encryption program that only belongs to you. It will take your Seed 961032 Phrase and convert it to something that looks like the following: D>IJJAJA@?[XKK\$<O%WDZ\$CRA@X)J@JXRJ?XY/C?/R>))BB] which is meaningless, without your particular Encryption/Decryption program. The program, called Switch48 functions on commuters and other devices and you will own the only copy that can decrypt your Seed Phrase/s, and it's free. The program operates without the internet, so nothing interacts with vour device.

The following steps will give you a unique copy of a program called Switch48.html. Please contact Bill on 0409 087876 if you need help to go through the following steps.

NOTE: If using an iPad, the downloaded files must be placed in the FILES Folder on the local device, not in the Cloud.

- 1) Download Switch48_Randomizer.html and Switch48.txt
- 2) Double Click on Switch48.txt to open it in your Windows Notepad
- 3) Scroll down about half way and you will see the following:

- 4) Select EXACTLY what you see highlighted above in Blue
- 5) Double Click on the file called Switch48_Randomizer.html
- 6) Press the Randomize button several times
- 7) Select all of the information displayed in the window below the Randomize Button
- 8) Copy the selected data into your device clipboard

- 9) Click on the very top margin of the Switch48.txt file
- 10) Paste the current Clipboard information over the highlighted data
- 11) Save the Switch48.txt file
- 12) RENAME the Switch48.txt file to Switch48.html (Say yes to any warning message)
- 13) Double Click on Switch48.html
- 14) Test it opens and functions properly
- 15) Delete the file called Switch48 Randomizer.html
- 16 Now you have a unique copy of Switch48.html, please copy it to some safe places?
